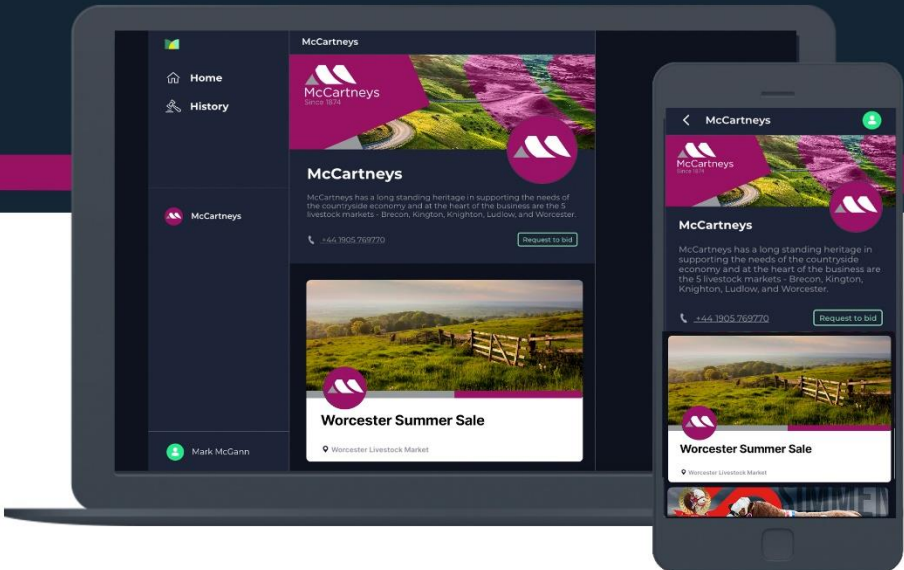

GENERAL INFORMATION AND SALE NOTES

LOCATION:

The show and sale will be held at Worcester Livestock Market, Nunnery Way, Worcester.

M5, Junction 6 – take the A4538 signposted Evesham, approx ½ mile at the 2nd roundabout, turn right, signposted Hospital A&E and city centre. Follow road going over motorway and you will see the market on the left. When you get to the next roundabout turn left and the market entrance is 300 metres on the left.

From Herefordshire – A44/A4103 to A4440 ring road, turn right going round Worcester following signs towards M5, when arriving at roundabout at top of hill, take left turn now following signs to Hospital A&E, still on the A4440 ring road. At the next roundabout turn right onto Swinesherd Way, follow dual carriageway, straight over first roundabout. You will notice the market on the right hand side, proceed right round the second roundabout, coming back on yourself, the entrance to the market is approx 300 metres on your left.

METHOD OF SALE:

All sheep will be sold in guineas.

CONDITIONS OF SALE:

The sale is held subject to the LAA and the Auctioneers General Conditions of Sale.

SETTLEMENT & CLEARANCE:

Settlement in full is due to the Auctioneers at the close of the sale. All sheep must be removed from the market on the day of sale.

INSPECTION:

All sheep forward for sale will be subject to a Society Inspection. Any animal which does not reach the Inspection standard will have a red mark put on their back, these animals will not be allowed to be sold and must be removed from the Sale pens immediately. Substitute lots will be given a coloured neck tie at the time of inspection. The inspector's decision will be final.

CONDITIONS OF SALE:

Sold under the British Berrichon Sheep Society Sale Rules and the Livestock Auctioneers Terms & Conditions of Sale. All sheep will be sold in guineas. A commission will be charged at 5.1% on all sheep. The pedigree and descriptions of the lots are believed to be correct, but are not intended as a warranty, and therefore shall be taken with all faults and errors of description.

SUBSTITUTES:

Two substitutes will be allowed provided that notification of ear numbers have been made to the Secretary 48 hours prior to the sale and pedigree papers are given to the Secretary prior to the Inspection. These animals will have a coloured neck tie placed on them at the time of Inspection. Substitutes must be like for like e.g Ram Lamb for Ram Lamb. Substitutes not notified to the Secretary will not be permitted for sale and must be removed from the sale area. All sheep must be tagged in accordance with the relevant DEFRA regulations. The Vendor shall be responsible for the correctness of identity and animals individual pedigree number must be printed on their tag. The vendor shall be responsible for all faults. The buyer has one hour after the end of sale to complain.

- 37.1 Vendor’s warranty Each female sheep is warranted not to be In Lamb at the time of sale. This warranty is a 14 weeks and 5 Day Warranty.
- 37.2 Purchaser’s rights If the Purchaser proves a breach of warranty the Vendor shall pay to the Purchaser as Liquidated Damages a sum equal to 33.33 per cent of the purchase price. Notice of a claim must be supported by a Veterinary Surgeon’s Certificate or a slaughter-house manager’s or other competent person’s certificate confirming the sheep to have been In Lamb for a period of at least 12 weeks on the day of sale.

- 38.1 Vendor’s warranty The Vendor warrants that a female sheep not described in any catalogue for sale or at the time of sale as In Lamb is not In Lamb at the time of sale. This warranty is a 14 Week + 5 Day Warranty.
- 38.2 Purchaser’s rights If the Purchaser proves a breach of warranty then, at the Purchaser’s option, either the Purchaser may exercise his rights under Schedule 6, or the Vendor shall pay to the Purchaser as Liquidated Damages a sum equal to the amount in paragraph (i) of the Appendix. Notice of a claim must be supported by a Veterinary Surgeon’s Certificate or a slaughterhouse manager’s or other competent person’s certificate confirming that the sheep was In Lamb

39 Female sheep described as correct

- 39.1 Vendor's warranty The Vendor warrants that all female sheep described in the catalogue or at the time of sale as correct are sound in mouth and udder, that is they are not lacking any of the 8 broad teeth and do not have any damaged or worn teeth or a defective udder. This warranty is a 5 Day Warranty.
- 39.2 Purchaser's rights If the Purchaser proves a breach of warranty then, at the Purchaser's option, either the Purchaser may exercise his rights under Schedule 6, or the Vendor shall pay to the Purchaser as Liquidated Damages a sum equal to the amount in paragraph (i) of the Appendix. Notice of a claim must be supported by a Veterinary Surgeon's Certificate.

40 Female sheep proving barren

- 40.1 Vendor's warranty The Vendor warrants that any female sheep sold as being In Lamb is In Lamb at the time of sale. This warranty is a 21 Day Warranty.
- 40.2 Purchaser's rights If the Purchaser proves a breach of warranty he may exercise his rights under Schedule 6. Notice of a claim must be supported by a Veterinary Surgeon's Certificate.

41 Ewes with lambs at foot

- 41.1 Vendor's warranty The Vendor warrants that, unless stated to the contrary in any catalogue for the sale or at the time of sale, in a Lot in which the ewes are described as with lamb or with lambs at foot every ewe is suckling one or more lambs, and every lamb has a mother in the Lot. This warranty is a 5 Day Warranty.
- 41.2 Purchaser's rights If the Purchaser proves a breach of warranty he may exercise his rights under Schedule 6 in respect of any ewe which does not have a lamb or any motherless lamb.

- 42.2 Purchaser's rights If the Purchaser proves a breach of warranty then, at the Purchaser's option, either he may exercise his rights under Schedule 6, or the Vendor shall pay to the Purchaser as Liquidated Damages a sum equal to 33.33 per cent of the purchase price of the sheep concerned. CONDITIONS OF SALE

1. The highest bidder shall be the purchaser and if any dispute shall arise between two or more bidders, the lot in dispute is to be put up again at the sum last bid or the Auctioneers may declare the purchaser.
2. The bidding is to be ruled by the auctioneers who may without giving any reason refuse to accept the bid of any person.
3. No person shall retract a bid without permission of the Auctioneers, who reserves the right to himself of refusing a bid, and also the right of withdrawing any lot or lots from the sale.
4. No bidder may advance less at a bid than the sum named from time to time by the Auctioneers.
5. The Purchaser must declare their name and address and if required to, pay the Auctioneers or his clerk the amount of purchase money immediately on the fall of the hammer. In default of which the lot or lots shall be offered again and re-sold, and under no circumstances must any lot be removed without first obtaining a pass from the clerk.
6. Title to each asset sold will only pass on payment in full by the Purchaser. Purchasers' attention is drawn to the Retention of Title clause 20.7 on the Conditions of Sale recommended for use in livestock auction markets by the Livestock Auctioneers Association as displayed in the sale office.
7. The Auctioneers reserve the right of deviating from the catalogue either by amalgamation or dividing the lots, as circumstances may require, and also by deviating from the order of sale.
8.
